LINE OF ACTION 2a: TRAUMATIC BRAIN INJURY/BEHAVIORAL HEALTH

TBI/BH is a software device used to accurately diagnose traumatic brain injuries and other behavioral health symptoms.

In March 2007, the President’s Commission on Care for America’s Wounded Warriors conducted a comprehensive review of the health care services provided to our military service members. As a result of the commission’s findings, Congress passed legislation for the development of a software solution focused on Traumatic Brain Injury and Behavioral Health to help health care providers accurately diagnose TBI through the use of baseline neurocognitive assessments.

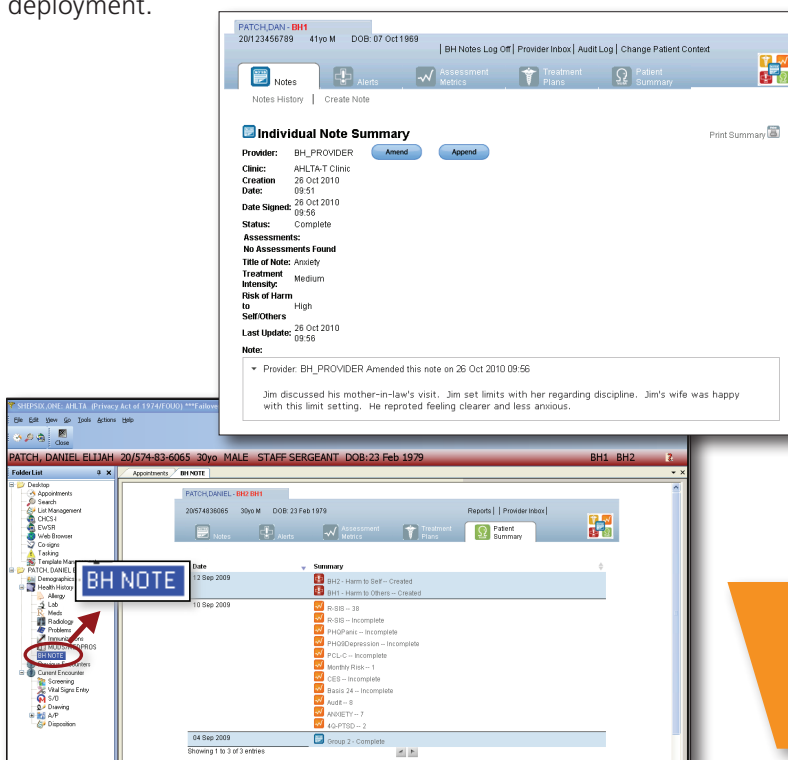
The Department of Defense established policies and a corresponding program to meet the needs of the military’s behavioral health community. The Defense Health Information Management System began developing a secure, enterprise-wide behavioral health system that will interface with existing MHS systems. Upon implementation, TBI/BH will improve behavioral health-related workflow and capabilities to meet the mandate requiring neurocognitive readiness assessments for all service members within six months of deployment.

Key Features

- ▶ Provides behavioral health alerts to notify MHS community of risks
- ▶ Allows providers to create secured behavioral health notes with free-text capabilities
- ▶ Provides access to authorized staff to administer behavioral health assessment questionnaires and incorporate corresponding results into each patient’s record
- ▶ Allows users to produce ad-hoc reports on behavioral health data

Key Benefits

- ▶ Provides access to TBI/BH capability within a common graphical user interface framework
- ▶ Enables providers to document behavioral health assessments for member groups and associate to individual group members
- ▶ Allows providers to efficiently manage treatment plans for associated patients
- ▶ Enhances security and privacy posture to users with behavioral health security key



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
